

MEMBERSHIP AND DUES

ARTICLE II – MEMBERSHIP

SECTION 1: NUMBER OF MEMBERS

Total membership shall not exceed thirty members

SECTION 2: MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

To become a member an individual must:

- Boater Member:
 - Participate in two tournaments within a four-month span.
- Be recommended for membership by a member in good standing.
- Have a genuine interest and display a basic proficiency in bass fishing skills.
- Obtain a current North Carolina fishing license and agree to keep said license current while a member.
- Be elected for membership by a simple majority of the present members at meeting in good standing.
- Each member will be given a liability form that releases the club, it's officers, agents and members from any liabilities.

SECTION 3: DUES

- Annual club membership dues shall be \$40.00, due at the beginning of the year for members and due upon installation of membership for new members
- Monthly club membership dues shall be \$10.00 regardless of participation in monthly tournament.
- Monthly tournament entry fees shall be \$30.00
- Prospective Member/Guest fees are \$10.00 payable at the tournament as entry into the big fish side pot. Guests are only eligible for participation in the big fish pot. A prospective member is only participating the big fish pot for the first 2 tournaments you participate in. Prospective member/guest do not pay into the tournament payouts and therefore do not receive the tournament payout but are eligible to win the big fish pot. The big fish pot is winner take all. Prospective members should fish the tournament as if they are members, not only weigh in your big fish, but also up to 4 additional fish per rules outlined above. The points and weights will apply to the yearly AOY points and weight totals. In other words, a prospective member is not penalized for their two big fish only tournaments, if they are voted in, their full tournament weight and points will be transferred to the yearly totals. Any member that is on a medical leave does not have to pay monthly dues for the period they are absent from the club.
